## It All Began With One Neighbor.

In 1990, founder and physician Joan Gault was distressed when an older colleague missed a community meeting because she could no longer drive. “When I retire,” Dr. Gault decided, “I’d like to do something about that.”

Determined to meet the needs of isolated senior citizens, she elicited support from community groups, formed a Board of Trustees for Interfaith Caregivers, a nonsectarian organization, and scheduled the first training session for volunteers. In that first year, we served 80 clients.

Caregivers has grown substantially from our grass roots beginnings—today volunteers help over 350 clients in Haddonfield and Haddon Heights—but our basic mission of neighbors helping neighbors through acts of kindness has not changed.

Volunteers, the heart of Interfaith Caregivers, handle over 120 appointments a week by

- Driving clients to medical appointments, stores, senior centers and more.
- Shopping for groceries and running errands.
- Visiting and providing companionship.
- Offering a break for family caregivers.
- Calling clients just to chat.
- Providing meals on a short-term basis.

Volunteers may also work in the office, serve on a committee, or offer expertise in finance, fund development, public relations and more. Volunteers include retirees, empty nesters, parents with small children, young professionals and students.
