

Ways Congregations Can Support Volunteer Caregiving

It is important to keep coalition members informed of the ways that they can extend their support. Many programs have benefited from congregational support such as the following:

- Sponsoring an annual fundraiser
- Providing space for volunteer recruitment and training
- Providing congregational coordinators to help support outreach to the congregation
- Regularly including information in bulletins and newsletters
- Encouraging congregational volunteers and care receivers to share their stories
- Writing letters welcoming new volunteers to the program
- Hosting a reception for congregation volunteers each year and having them invite a potential new volunteer to the celebration
- Including *your program* in the annual budget
- Hosting a commissioning service for caregiving volunteers and taking up an offering of support
- Writing letters of support for fundraising efforts
- Supporting your program with in-kind support including computer equipment, work or meeting space, copy/printing expenses, office supplies, etc.
- Serving on the board of directors or ad hoc committees
