The Qura'n encourages generosity in volunteerism, kindness and charity. The following verses indicate the attention and priority that the Qura'n has given to help and to support those who are in need regardless of their ethnic or religious background.

In Chapter (4) named "Women," the Qura'n states:

Serve Allah, and join not any partners with Him; and do good-to parents, kinsfolk, orphans, those in need, neighbors who are near, neighbors who are strangers, the companion by your side, the wayfarer (ye meet), (Surah 4/36)

In chapter 76 named "the Man" and "the Time," the Quran states:

And they feed, for the love of Allah, the indigent, the orphan, and the captive. (Saying)," We feed you for the sake of Allah alone: no reward do we desire from you, nor thanks. (Surah 76/8-9).

The Prophet (peace be upon him) encouraged showing mercy to others as the condition for eligibility of receiving mercy from Allah S.W.T. in his statement which translates to: "The one who does not show mercy will not be shown mercy."

The Prophet (peace be upon him) also said:

"Show mercy to those who are on earth, you will be shown mercy by the one who is above the Sky."

Furthermore, the criteria for determining who is best and who is the closest to Allah has been outlined by this great Prophet (peace be upon him) as follows: "The best of human beings is the one who is most beneficial to them."

and:

"The creatures are the dependents of Allah and the dearest of them to Allah is the one who is most beneficial to His dependents."
